## **The Student Council**

The Student Council is an elected body of student representatives which includes Fine Arts Secretaries, Sports Secretaries, Association Secretaries, Department Secretaries and Part V Secretaries (NSS, NCC,YRC, etc). They are guided and coordinated by the Vice Principals and Deans for Student Affairs under the dynamic leadership of the Principal. The Student Council members take an active lead in all the activities of the academe..

The Student Council functions as a connecting link between the student community and the administrative body. The institution through the Council provides a means to the students to voice out their suggestions and grievances in the meetings of the academic and non statutory bodies. The Council is encouraged to actively involve in the chief events and celebrations of the college and organize campaigns and outreach programme for the benefit the students and rural community.

#### **Student Council Election**

The Council as a representative structure is trained for a leadership with democratic perception. In materializing the same, the representatives for various positions are elected by students themselves. The election for the posts of Fine Arts Secretary, Sports Secretary and Women Secretary are held separately for Shift I and Shift II. The candidates are allowed to present their election manifestos to the students in the presence of the Monitoring Committee. The casting and counting of votes are done digitally by using computers. The Electoral Committee headed by the Dean for Student Affairs coordinates the entire process.
