## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Arul Anandar College is 53 years old. It was founded in 1970 as De La Salle College by the late Most Rev. Dr. Justin Diraviam, Catholic Archbishop of Madurai, with pre-degree course and undergraduate programme in Economics and in Philosophy. In 1972 it became a Jesuit Institution and it was re-named as Arul Anandar College with many other Arts and Science programmes having the vision "Integral Development of Rural Students and Empowering them for Social Transformation." It was the youngest college to reach the status of autonomy in 1987. The NAAC accredited the college at FIVE STAR in 2001, reaccredited (2nd Cycle) at 'A' grade with a CGPA of 3.52 in 2008 and again reaccredited (3rd Cycle) at 'A' grade with a CGPA of 3.66 in 2014. It is accredited at "A" Grade with a CGPA of 3.15 (4th Cycle) in 2022.

## ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of English Language and Literature was established in 2011 with a supreme vision of providing "Integrated formation to the rural students towards leadership and empowerment through Literature" with 65 students and four staff members. As a maiden Department, its primary objectives were to introduce the learners to the art of the English language and to inculcate the values which are embedded in literature.
