The students arranged general Medical Camps, Eye Camps, Veterinary Camps and Legal Awareness Camps for people in the neighborhood as part of the neighborhood development initiative. STUDENT SUPPORT PROGRAMME/SERVICES

LIBRARY: The library this year was augmented with more than 1000 books. Apart from the existing journals subscribed another 6 have been added to the list. On an average 225 students visit the library every day for enhancing their knowledge. The library also has the practice of honoring the student who uses the library to its best. I congratulate Dr.Duraisingam and his team.

HOSTELS: The hostel provides wonderful opportunities in order to bring the latent talents of boys and girls. Special attention is provided to the inmates of the hostel to take care of their body and mind through sports and cultural activities. Special talks by eminent persons are given to students to improve their knowledge and equip them with skills to face the competitive world outside. There are more than 750 inmates in the Boys hostel and 300 inmates in the girl's hostel. The Hostel is administered ably by Rev.Dr.M.Anbuarasu SJ, Rev.Dr. Godwin Rufus SJ and Sr. Arul Shiny.

MENTOR CARE: The Mentor Care under the able leadership of Rev.Dr.SebastianMahimairaj OCD has been organizing a series of programmes facilitating the improvement of students and training the staff. Some of the programmes organized by the Mentor Care Unit were First Aid in Mental Health, Mobile Addiction, Alcoholic Addiction and Blue Whale Game: A Threat.

TRAINING AND PLACEMENT CELL: The career guidance and placement cell of Arul Anandar College conducts regular training programmes that enhance the soft skills of the students to make them employable. Training programmes on Soft Skills, How to attend Interviews and Resume Writing were organized. Suguna Foods, IDBI Bank, SNP Dairy were some of the companies that visited the college to recruit students. The students also participated in a number of Off Campus Interviews organized in other colleges. I thank Dr.S.Arul Prasad and his team on their efforts.

FOUNDATION COURSES: The Department of Foundation Course organized a special orientation programme on Personality Development and Environmental Studies for the faculty members handling foundation courses. A special workshop was organized on the theme "Towards Human Excellence: Developing Skills for Foundation Courses". Programmes on "E-Waste management in the Technological Society", "Addiction and advantages of mobile and electronic gadgets", "Social Analysis on Human Rights- Issues and Challenges: The Need of Our Times" were organized for the benefit of students.

OTHER CONTRIBUTING COMMITTEES/DEPARTMENTS

WEB COMMITTEE: Our College website is upgraded as a CMS (Content Management System), and this helps to manage the college Web information from the server database. A separate API is also developed by Mr.B.Johnson, Web Committee in-charge, to update the college web information along with the committee members. A separate Module for Alumni is also included in the college website to maintain the alumni information. Further, the Committee has planned to introduce the E-payment system for students to pay their college tuition and exam fee online through the website.

CAMPUS MINISTRY: The Campus Ministry of Arul Anandar College is a very active ministry which caters to the spiritual needs of the campus by nurturing and nourishing in them the Ignatian spirit and the Jesuit way of proceeding in almost all the activities of the campus. The new Bishop of Kottar, Rt Rev Dr Nazarene Soosai was the main celebrant for the Mass of the Holy Spirit. The Feast of Saint Ignatius of Loyola, St Francis Xavier and St Arul Anandar were celebrated with piety and devotion with novenas of which at least four prayer services are conducted with the students along with variety of competitions on the feast day of the respective Saints. I appreciate the various initiatives taken by the Campus Ministry and its Leader Rev.Fr.Godwin Rufus SJ.

PTA MEETING: The PTA meeting is organized to create an interface between the parents, staff and members of the Management. The PTA meeting for the II U.G. and II P.G. was held on 20th January, 2018 with the participation of 197 parents, the PTA meeting for the III U.G. students was held on 10th February, 2018 and 154 parents participated in this event.
