Special talks by eminent persons are given to students to improve their knowledge and equip them with skills to face the competitive world outside. There are more than 750 inmates in the Boys hostel and 300 inmates in the girl's hostel. The Hostel is administered ably by Rev.Dr.M.Anbuarasu SJ, Rev.Dr. Godwin Rufus SJ and Sr. Arul Shiny.

MENTOR CARE: The Mentor Care under the able leadership of Rev.Dr.SebastianMahimairaj OCD has been organizing a series of programmes facilitating the improvement of students and training the staff. Some of the programmes organized by the Mentor Care Unit were First Aid in Mental Health, Mobile Addiction, Alcoholic Addiction and Blue Whale Game: A Threat.
