ADMISSIONS

In this academic year 2019-2020, 460 students were admitted to UG courses and 28 students were admitted for PG courses in the aided section. In the Self-Financed section, 686 students joined the UG programme and 92 students joined the PG programme. The total strength of the students in Aided courses is 1136 and the total strength of the students in Self-Financed courses is 2084.

STUDENTS SUPPORT SERVICES

LIBRARY

Our College library has 63000 books. This year 1350 books were purchased under the various Grants. There are about 107 Journal and Periodicals, including 6 International Journals and also 9 dailies have been subscribed and newly four journals have been added this academic year. The average numbers of student and staffs visiting library per day is 518. An Orientation Program was provided regarding Library Information Service and the availability of books, Journals and magazines to all first year UG and PG Students at the beginning of the academic year. Every year the library honours the Best Reader with an award.

CENTRE FOR WOMEN'S STUDIES

Women's Studies Centre organized an orientation programme on the general code of discipline, health, hygiene, and facilities available to them on the campus and

were enlightened with the need and importance of education for their empowerment. An awareness programme on Human Rights and Social Justice, women and legal rights, Building Better Self Esteem for Women and Formation of Self Help Groups were arranged for women students. I appreciate the services of Ms. M. Pandeewari in coordinating these activities.

MOOC'S (SWAYAM)

Study Web Active Learning for Young Aspiring Mindis a programme initiated by government of INDIA to attract students towards e learning. The objective of this course is to take the best teaching learning to all. SWAYAM seeks to be a bridge between the digital divide and the students are still being untouched with digital world. Twenty teaching fraternity and 15 students have attended the exam and got certificates.

HOSTELS

The academic year 2019-20 commenced with Rev Dr S Paul Pragash SJ continuing as the Director of Hostel and Bro Kulandairaj SJ and Fr. John Innaci SJ as the Deputy Directors successively. In order to train the boys in communication skills, special Spoken English classes are conducted, and 'Word a Day' is followed. A well-furnished Reading Hall and a library with select collection invite hostellers to update themselves on current issues and affairs through newspapers, magazines and books.

The new compound wall around the Hostel, the enhanced public address system, the separate IDs issued to the boys, the new digital clocks fixed in the wings and blocks, the mosquito mesh to the windows and the solar panels besides Biogas underway, are the facilities annexed to the hostel this year that give a face-lift to the enticing Hostel ambience.

The 650 plus boys accommodated in six halls and blocks with equal number of Assistant Directors, Profs Stalin, Prasanth, Sajan Joseph, Rex, Subash and Xavier, are guided and helped to excel in their studies and well-rounded development.

Girl's Hostel creates an excellent milieu for the rural and the economically poor students, under the able administration of Rev. Sr. Arul Shiney SJA, Director of Women's Hostel. 61 deserving students have been given hostel fee concession. Various

committees like liturgy, choir, cultural, sports, mess, discipline, and decoration committee are formed to involve the students in hostel administration and to hold diverse responsibilities.

MENTOR CARE

The Mentor Care programme of Arul Anandar College is one of its best practices. The students are assigned a faculty and they travel along with the students as their Mentor. The mentor plays the role of a parent in the institution taking care of the psycho social needs of the mentee. Students who need professional help are then referred the College Counselor. The mentor meets the mentee at regular intervals twice every semester. However, they are free to meet the mentor when they desire. The Mentor programme is organized during the 1st hour on an assigned day. I sincerely thank Rev.Fr. J.M.Das SJ in helping to stream line the programme effectively.

CAREER GUIDANCE AND PLACEMENT CELL

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell plays a catalytic role helping students get placed in reputed companies and provide regular training programmes on soft skills, placement skills and career guidance. HCL a lead software company organized a campus interview in the College Premises on 13 Dec, 2019. Six students were offered placement letters.
