The previous record in the similar category is held by Mr. Eric of USA who cycled (without holding) a distance of 37.5km in one hour in 2009. According to Mr. V.T. Vignesh Kumar he attempted this record to create awareness among the students and general public on the issue of 'Global Warming'. He said that this attempt would motivate people to use bicycles and less use of fuel based vehicles. Mr. Solai E.
