

DEPARTMENT OF PHILOSOPHY

The Second year Philosophy students (21 students), Arul Anandar College, go once a week on regular basis for programme to the neighboring villages namely Janatha coloy, Cettiampatti, Vakakkampatti, Azhagusirai, Kovilangulam, Kottaiyur, Ariyapatti, Piraviampatti and Kalingapatti. In all these villages the following activities are carried out: taking tuition, teaching moral values, visiting families, listening and caring of the elderly people, and training the children in performing arts and conducting entertainment programmes.

The students go in groups and involve themselves in educating the school going children from Pre K.G. to 12th Standing, by teaching them English grammar and training them to reading practice, helping them to develop [writing skills, making them efficient in various subjects such as mathematics, History, Tamil, and Social Science etc. Special attention is given to the 10th and 12th Standard students for writing the Government Public Examinations to the best their abilities. Knowing the importance of teaching moral values to the young children, our students teach them moral values by means of stories, life of great personalities, freedom fighter, social activists, sages and saints. The students also conduct games and sports at the end of very visit, helping the students to grow in physical skills and make them active and healthy.

Visiting the families in the villages is an important part of the students' activities. Listing to the problems and difficulties of the families both comforts the psychological stress of the villagers and strengthens the social consciousness in our students. The students also visit Mercy Home, Azhgusirai, where the orphaned children and abandoned elderly parents are taken care. The concern and affection of the students make those inmates to fell as if they are meeting their own family members. The children are trained by our students through the year in various performing arts and at the end of the year the students conduct special annual day programme where all children participate in various competitions and cultural programmes. These activities create in the children a sense of self-worth, confidence, and fulfillment. Thus the second year Philosophy students of Arul Anandar College bring out a lot of positive impacts through the ARISE programme in the lives of the children and the people of the neighboring villages.
