REPORT

Paining competition on G20 Presidency India organized by National Cadet Corps held at Arul Anandar College, Karumathur was a grant success. The primary aim of the painting competition on G20 Presidency India is to promote awareness and understanding among the participating Part V Unit students about the significance and responsibilities associated with India's G20 Presidency. The competition aims to encourage creativity and artistic expression while fostering a sense of global citizenship and engagement in the students.

OBJECTIVES

- Promote India's role and contributions as the G20 Presidency holder.
- Encourage artistic expression and creativity among participants.
- Foster awareness and understanding of the G20 and its significance.
- Highlight India's vision and priorities during its G20 Presidency.
- Facilitate cross-cultural exchange and dialogue through art.

EVENT DETAILS

The painting competition on G20 Presidency India took place on July 13, 2023, from 2 to 4 pm at Diraviam Arrangam in Arul Anandar College, Karumathur. The event was inaugurated by Dr.Nirmalrajkumar, Dean of Students and felicitated by Rev.Dr.A.Antonysamy SJ, Secretary. The event saw participation from approximately 40 students representing various Part V units, including the National Service Scheme (NSS), Youth Red Cross (YRC), Nature Club, AICUF, Physical Education, and the National Cadet Corps (NCC)

ACTIVITIES

- Announcement and Registration: The competition was announced on 06 July 2023 among the Part five students through respective part V coordinators, and interested participants were asked to register their names with the NCC Officer.
- **Briefing Session**: A briefing session was conducted on the same day of the competition with the aim to provide participants with information about the G20 and India's presidency, including its significance, objectives, and priorities. This session aimed to equip the students with the necessary knowledge to create meaningful artworks.

- **Painting Competition**: The participants were given a specific duration form 2 to 4 pm to create their paintings based on the theme of India's G20 Presidency. They were provided with the required art supplies and materials to express their creativity.
- **Evaluation and Judging**: The Coordinator, Media Center, Arul Anandar College who experienced in artists skill evaluated the paintings based on the following criteria,
 - o Relevance to the chosen theme.
 - o Creativity and originality.
 - o Technical skill and execution.
 - Visual impact and composition
- **Exhibition and Presentation**: The artworks were displayed in an exhibition ON 17 July 2023, allowing students, faculty, and visitors to appreciate the creative expressions of the participants. During the exhibition, a brief presentation was given to explain the significance of the G20 Presidency and how it relates to each artwork.

OUTCOMES

- Awareness and Understanding: The competition succeeded in raising awareness among the Part five students about India's G20 Presidency, its importance in global affairs, and the country's role in shaping international agendas.
- Artistic Expression: The competition provided a platform for students to showcase their artistic skills and creativity, encouraging them to explore new ways of expressing their thoughts and ideas through visual art.
- **Promotion of Global Citizenship**: By engaging with the theme of G20 Presidency, the competition promoted a sense of global citizenship and encouraged students to think beyond national boundaries, fostering their understanding of global issues and the importance of cooperation among nations.
- **Appreciation of Diversity**: The artworks showcased a variety of perspectives, highlighting the diversity of thoughts and interpretations among the participants. This fostered an appreciation for different viewpoints and encouraged dialogue on global issues.
- **Recognition and Awards**: Based on the evaluation by the judge, outstanding artworks three students were recognized and awarded, others were given participants certificate to acknowledging their artistic talent and effort.



Art Medium: Artworks must be created using traditional painting mediums on a standard canvas/board. The use of digital tools or software is not allowed.

Art Supplies: Participants must bring their own art supplies, including paints, brushes, and any other necessary materials.

Originality: Artworks should be original and must not violate any copyright laws. Any inappropriate or offensive content will lead to disqualification.

Selection Criteria

The selection of winning artworks will be based on the following criteria:

- Relevance to the chosen theme.
- Creativity and originality.
- Technical skill and execution.
- Visual impact and composition.

Prizes:

Winners: Medal and Certificate of Excellence.

All other participants: Certificate of Participation.
