- One student can participate in a maximum of **THREE** events only.
- Last date for submitting Songs for all dance competitions, Karaoke for all singing competitions and Lyrics for Folk song is **12.12.2024 at 4.00 pm.**
- Participants should produce their **IDENTITY CARDS** before each event for scrutiny.
- They must reach the venue 15 minutes before the commencement of the event.
- Accompanists from other departments are not allowed in any event.

**NOTE:**

Dialogues with double meaning, criticism over college management, staff, the departments, mentioning the names of the government officials and any form of obscenity are to be strictly avoided. The sensitive, political and religious controversial and contentious issues should not be brought to the stage. The Vice Presidents (Staffs-in-Charge) of the associations will bear the responsibility of instructing their department wards to strictly follow the rules and regulations. Any violation of the rules will lead to disqualification.

- Lots will be drawn before the day of competitions at 04.00 pm.
- the Secretary of the Association Only must draw lots.
- The team will participate in the respective event as per the lots drawn.

**POINTS:**

Every event carries the following points:


- First Place - 15 points**

**PENALTY:**


- If a team does not turn up even after three consecutive calls, the team concerned will be **DISQUALIFIED** from the event.
- No second chance will be given at any cost.


**QUERIES:**





### RULES FOR PRACTICE


- Students should practice **after 2.15 pm** duly monitored by staff in charge

- ❖ Duration – 3+1 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department is 1
- ❖ No hints paper are allowed during the competitions
- ❖ The topic will be given before 30 minutes of the commencement of the event.
- ❖ Participants should speak not less than 3 minutes on the topics additional 1 minute can be given if he/she wants.
- ❖ Content should be adhering to the given topic.
- ❖ Other language words, quotes, phrases should not be used while speaking

### **2. Elocution (English)**

- ❖ Duration – 3+1 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department is 1
- ❖ No hints paper are allowed during the competitions
- ❖ The topic will be given before 30 minutes of the commencement of the event.
- ❖ Participants should speak not less than 3 minutes on the topics additional 1 minute can be given if he/ she wants.
- ❖ Content should be adhering to the given topic.
- ❖ Other language words, quotes, phrases should not be used while speaking

### **3. Kadhai Solli**

- ❖ Duration – 3 + 1 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department is 1

- ❖ Story should be the combination of fantasy, emotion and realistic.
- ❖ Content should be adhering to the given situation.

- ❖ Language – Tamil or English
- ❖ Posters can be done using Canava App only.
- ❖ Venue: College Computer Lab

#### **5. Photography**

- ❖ Duration - 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department - 1
- ❖ Photographs captured inside the campus alone will be considered for the judgment

- ❖ The camera only should be used for capturing photos
- ❖ Mobile phones are not allowed
- ❖ Photo should have been taken with date and time imprinted

#### **6. Pencil Drawing**

- ❖ Duration - 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department – 1
- ❖ The theme is *War free Earth*
- ❖ Black lead pencils (Graphite pencils) should only be used
- ❖ Chart papers will be provided
- ❖ All the remaining materials should be brought by the participants
- ❖ Do not bring any printed or written materials

### **7. Wealth From Waste**

It is a competition of creating art products from the waste

- ❖ Duration – 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department – a team of 2 participants
- ❖ The theme is your choice
- ❖ Participants should bring waste or any other unusable or unwanted materials
- ❖ The waste materials should not be pre-assembled
- ❖ No markings of pencils or sketches or color on the waste materials
- ❖ The waste materials should be presented for inspection before the commencement of the event & completely collected after the event.

### **8. Fireless Cooking**

- ❖ Duration - 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department – 2
- ❖ Participants should name the dish and display it.
- ❖ Participants should not bring any pre - cooked items.
- ❖ Dishes should be purely vegetarian.
- ❖ Participants should not bring cut chopped are grates raw materials.
- ❖ Participants can bring non electrical equipments like mixture, chopper, juicer, Grater etc.,

### **9. Rangoli**

- ❖ Duration – 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department – a team of 2 members
- ❖ The theme is *Constitution - 75*
- ❖ Participants should bring their own materials
- ❖ No captions and labels are permitted
- ❖ Do not bring any printed or written materials
- ❖ After the event, participants should clean their allotted space

### **10. Face Painting**

- ❖ Duration - 1 hour
- ❖ No. of participants per department – a team of 2 participants
- ❖ The theme will be given on the spot
- ❖ Removable paints only are allowed
- ❖ The design should not be extended to the neck or ears
- ❖ Participants should bring their own materials
- ❖ Labels and stickers are prohibited
- ❖ Do not bring any printed or written materials

### **PERFORMING ARTS**

### **11. Folk Dance (Group)**

- ❖ Duration - Maximum of 4 minutes including stage settings
- ❖ No. of participants per department: a team of maximum of 7 members (minimum 6 members)
- ❖ It may be of any Indian folk dance
- ❖ Cine songs are not allowed
- ❖ Musical accompaniment can be brought by the participants
- ❖ The song for the dance should be submitted to the competitions committee by means of pen drive before the previous day of the event
- ❖ The song should get the approval of the scrutiny committee
- ❖ Playing of the folk instruments is permitted

*1. Coordination*

*2. Properties and costume*

*3. Choreography*

### **12. Short Film Making**

- ❖ This is a group activity
- ❖ No. of participants per department – Maximum of 10 members
- ❖ The theme is your choice
- ❖ Duration of the film: Maximum of 3 minutes
- ❖ Acting, Editing, Direction, Videography, rerecording, Sound mixing should be done by participants only
- ❖ Students should shoot the film by their own equipments (camera, stand, etc.)
- ❖ The film may be shot outside the campus also.
- ❖ Participants should submit their videos to the Students Dean's office along with copy right declaration before **18 December 2024, 01.30 pm**

### **13. Pair Dance**

- ❖ Duration - Maximum of 4 minutes
- ❖ No. of pair per department – 1 (2 participants only)
- ❖ Male pairs must be performing in male roles and female pairs in female roles. A woman in a male role and man in a female role are not allowed.
- ❖ Members of pair should be same gender
- ❖ Song from any regional language is permitted
- ❖ The song should not convey any double meaning, and unacceptable music while dancing.
- ❖ The song for the dance should be submitted to the competitions committee by means of pen drive before the previous day of the event
- ❖ The song should get the approval of the scrutiny committee

#### **Judging criteria:**

**1. Synchronization 2. Properties and Costumes 3. Choreography**

### **14. Solo Singing**

- ❖ Duration – 4 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department – 1
- ❖ No musical instrument should be used
- ❖ Karaoke is allowed
- ❖ The karaoke music should be submitted to the competitions committee before the previous day of the event

#### **Judging criteria:**

**1. Taalam 2. Raagam 3. Pronunciation and clarity**

### **15. Fusion Dance (Group)**

- ❖ Duration - Maximum of 4 minutes including stage settings
- ❖ No. of participants per department: a team of maximum of 7 members
- ❖ Dance should be mixed song, classical / semi classical / western / pop at least fusion of any two.
- ❖ Participants may be either male or female or mix of both (mix should be an even number).
- ❖ The song for the dance should be submitted to the competitions committee by means of pen drive before the previous day of the event
- ❖ The song should get the approval of the scrutiny committee before 12-12-24 at 4.00 pm.

#### **Judging criteria:**

**1. Coordination 2. Properties and costume 3. Choreography**

### 16. Solo Dance

- ❖ Duration - Maximum of 4 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department – 1
- ❖ Song from any regional language is permitted
- ❖ The song should not convey any double meaning, Dialogues and unacceptable music while dancing.
- ❖ The song for the dance should be submitted to the competitions committee by means of pen drive before the previous day of the event
- ❖ The song should get the approval of the scrutiny committee before 12-12-24 at 4.00 pm.
- ❖ Properties can be used

1. Skills                      2. Properties and Costumes                      3. Choreography

### 17. Group Song

- ❖ Duration - 4 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department - maximum 6
- ❖ Minimum 4 participants should sing
- ❖ Either Musical instruments or Karaoke is allowed
- ❖ The karaoke music should be submitted to the competitions committee before the previous day of the event
- ❖ The song should not convey any double meaning, Dialogues and unacceptable music

#### Judging criteria:

1. Taalam & Raagam    2. Tuning the instruments/ Karaoke    3. Pronunciation and clarity

### 18. Mime


- ❖ Duration: 4 minutes
- ❖ No. of participants per department: a team of a maximum of 8 students
- ❖ The background music for the mime should be submitted to the competitions committee by means of pen drive on the previous day of the event
- ❖ Use of words and properties are prohibited
- ❖ The theme is *War free Earth*




